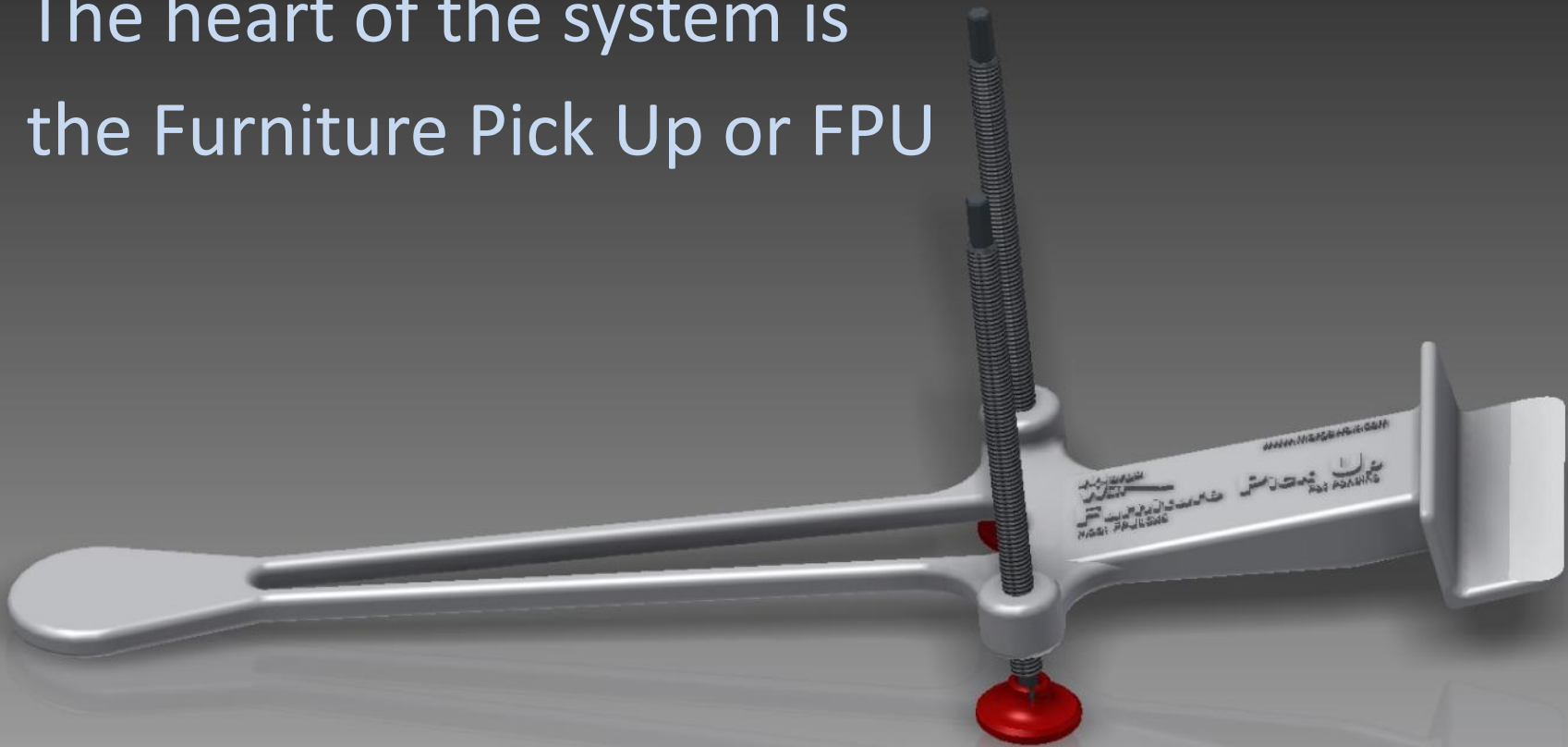

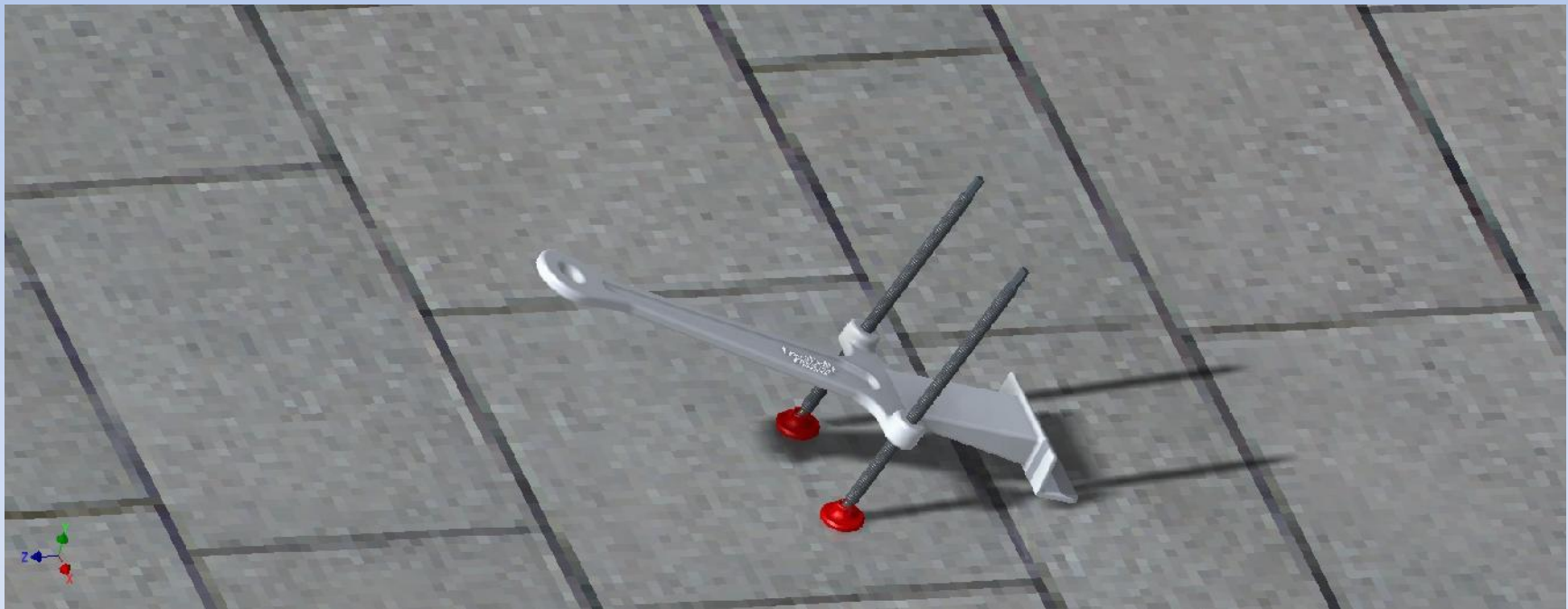
Furniture Lifting

The heart of the system is
the Furniture Pick Up or FPU



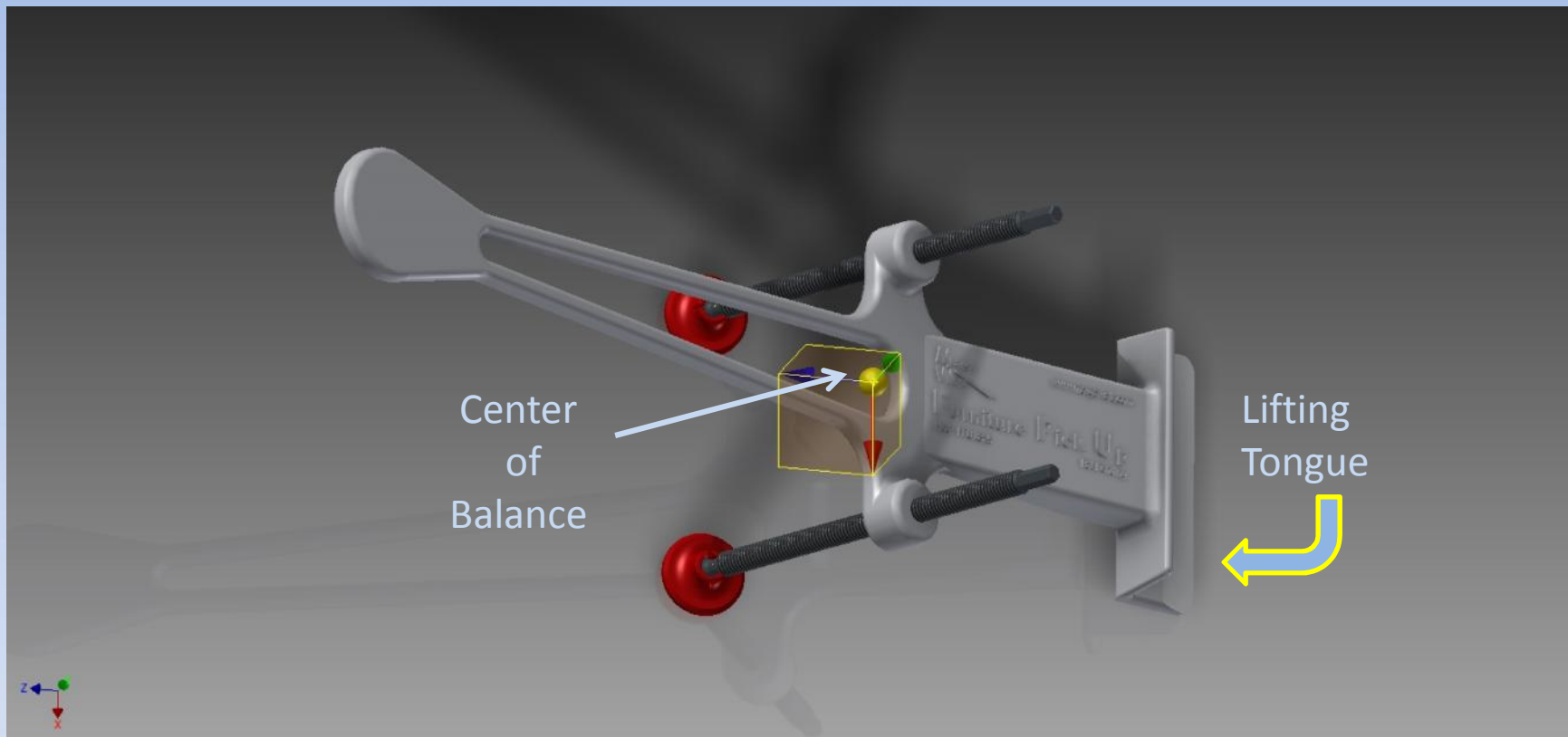


Carefully designed for easy use



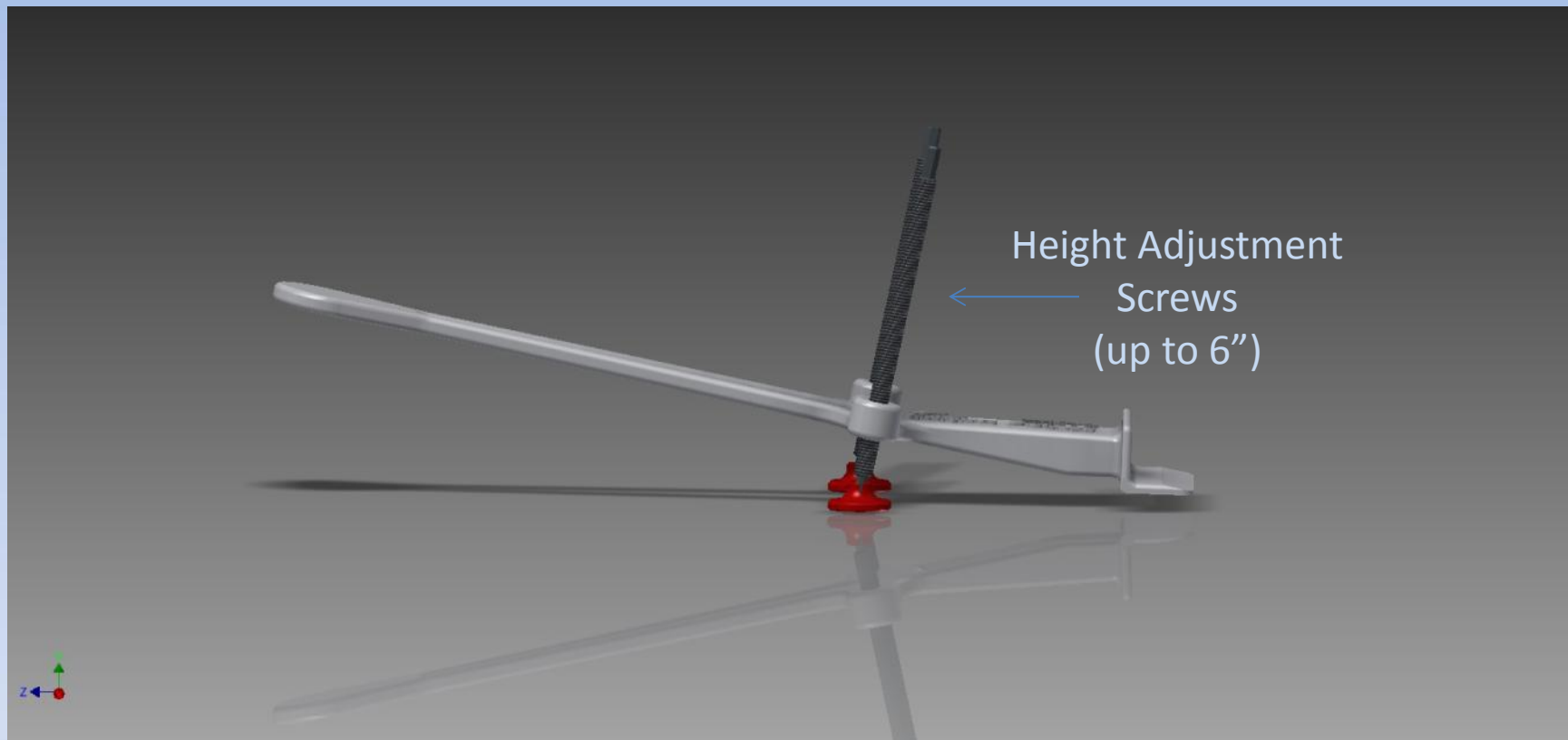
The FPU is carefully balanced to stay where you put it..
When you lean it forward, it stays that way, making it easier to pick up.

Center of balance



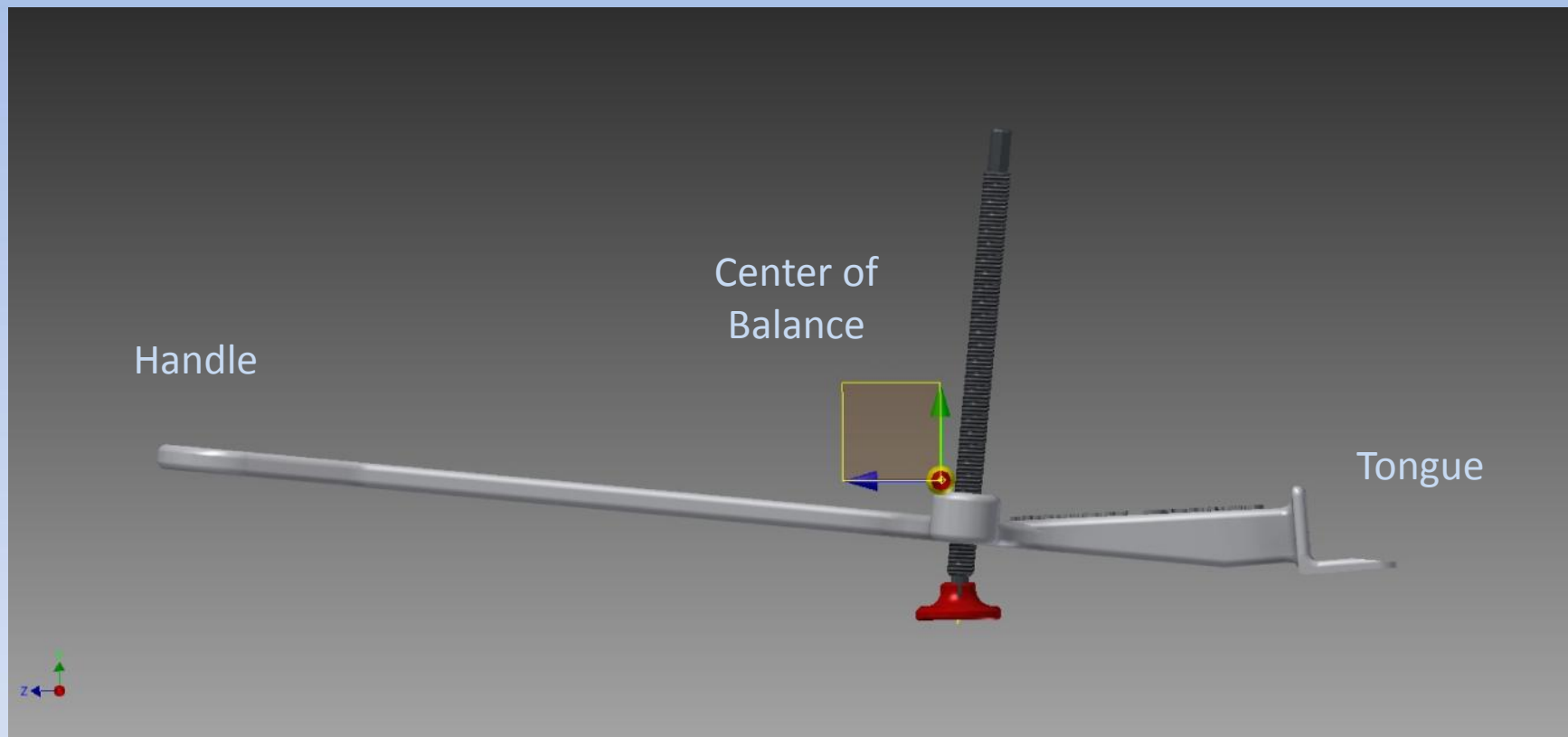
The center of balance is notated by the yellow dot. Notice that it is between the red pads and the lifting tongue. This means that the handle is high up for easy grabbing without stooping.

Center of Balance



Even when the height adjustment is set almost all the way down, the lifting tongue “sticks” to the ground. As long as the device is tilted forward, it will stay that way.

The Balance shifts



As the lifting bar approaches level, the handle begins to weigh more than the tongue. Note that the center of balance is now behind the center of the red lift pad. That means that the lifting tongue will tend to stick to the underside of the chest once placed.

Lifting the chest

- Most chests have feet.
- Can easily work with 1/8" pads
- Works up to 6" tall feet
- (Taller bars available)



Because the FPU tends to “stick” to the underside of the chest, lifting it is simply a matter of pressing on the handle.

Lifted Chest

- 2.5 to 1 advantage
- Easy to lift



Now let's put the Furniture movers in place so we can easily move the chest.

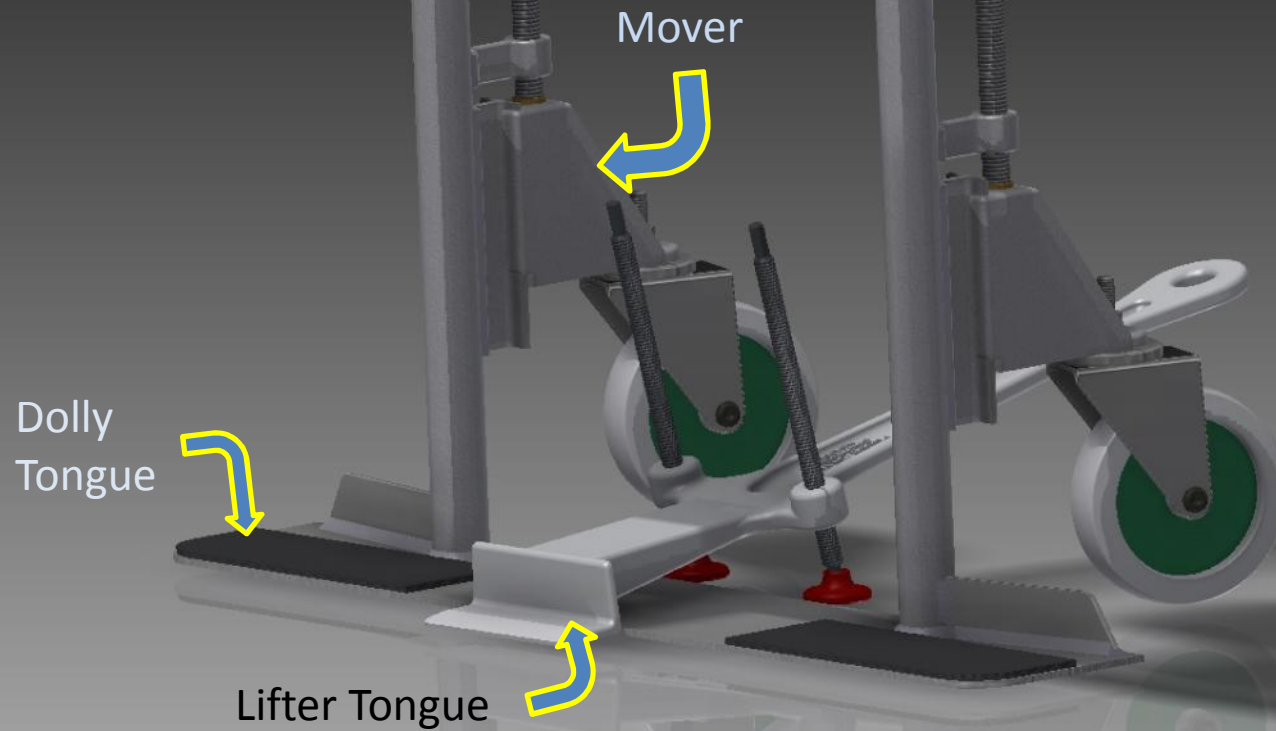
Moving on Wheels

- Wheels are much easier than skids.
- They won't scratch floors
- One man operation.



The furniture movers lift the feet almost an inch off the floor.
All four Wheels swivel so you can turn on a dime

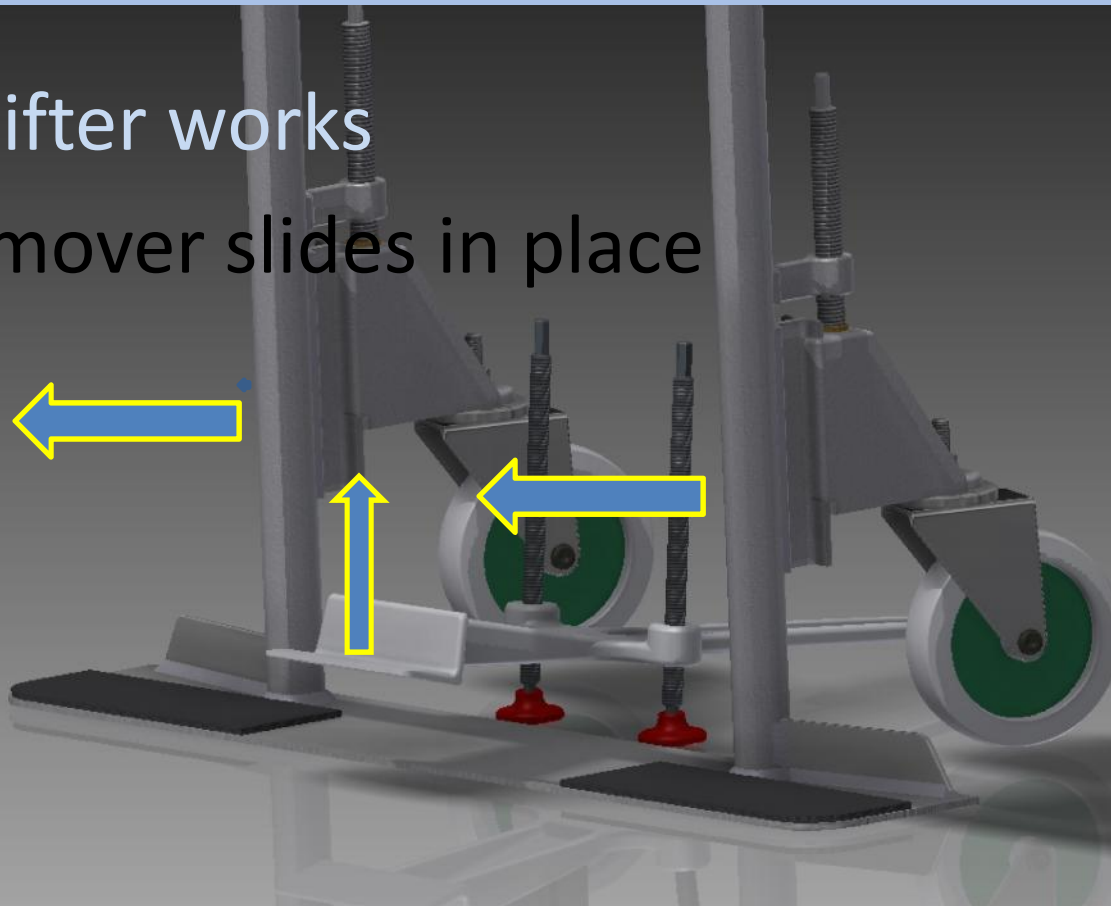
Mover design



Note how the lifter tongue is in front of the dolly tongue but the red pads are behind it. This allows you to lift the chest and easily slide the mover into place.

Mover design

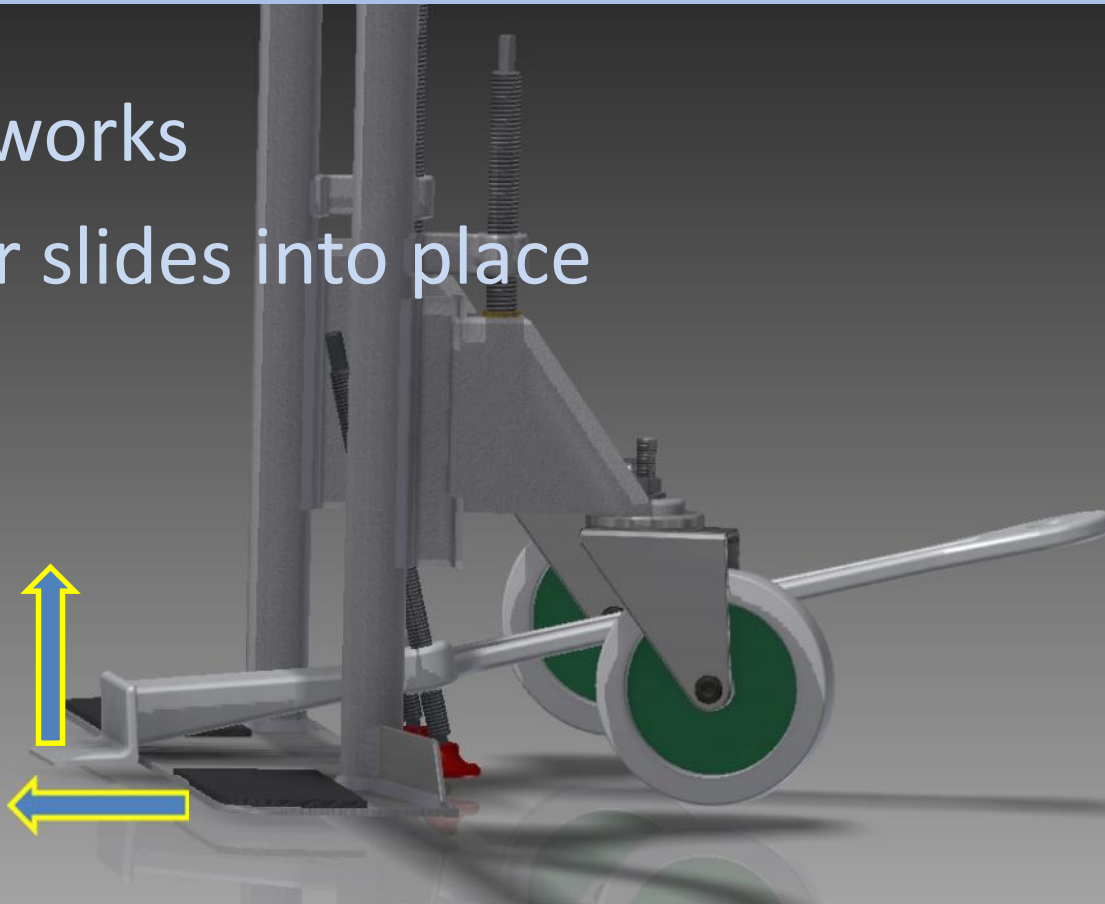
- The lifter works

Ease of use and speed of operation helps this to work well

Integrated Ratchet Strap

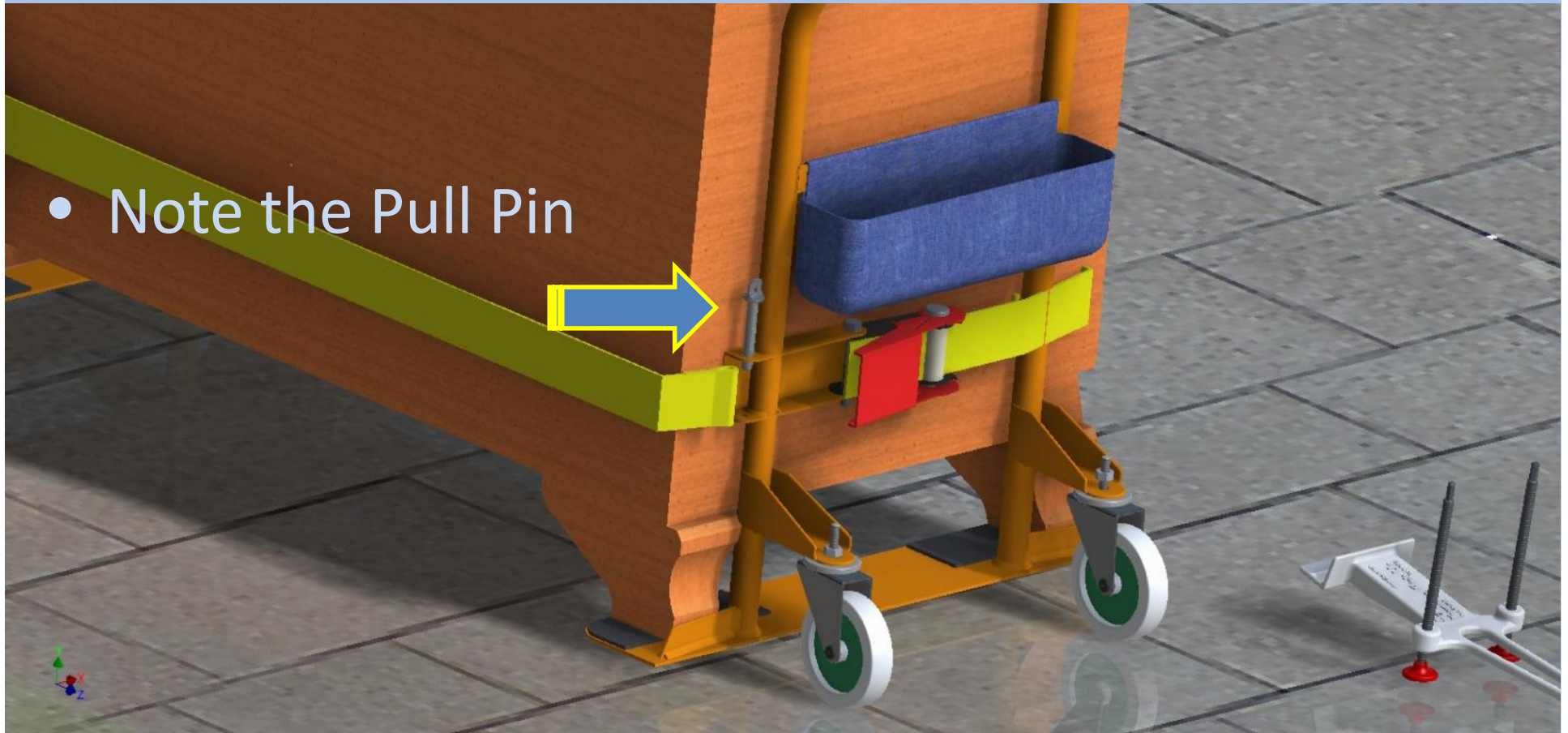
- Easy to use
- Storage on board.



The blue storage pouch is designed to hold the extra yellow strap

Easy Strap Hold Down

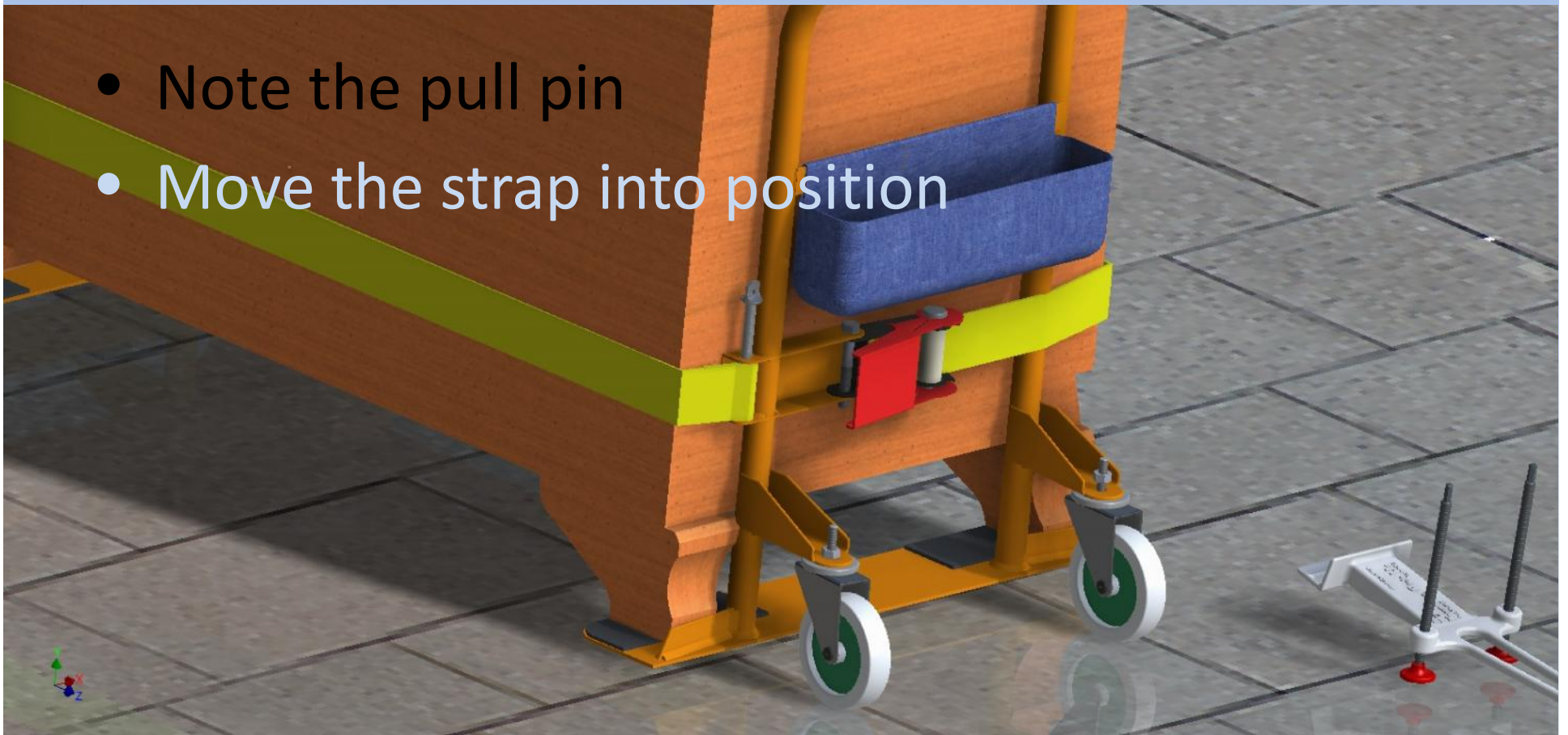
- Note the Pull Pin



This makes it easier to quickly get the securing strap into place..
Pull it to quickly remove the strap from the chest.

Easy Strap Hold Down

- Note the pull pin
- Move the strap into position



Easy Strap Hold Down

- Note the pull pin
- Move the strap into position
- Slide the Pin to lock

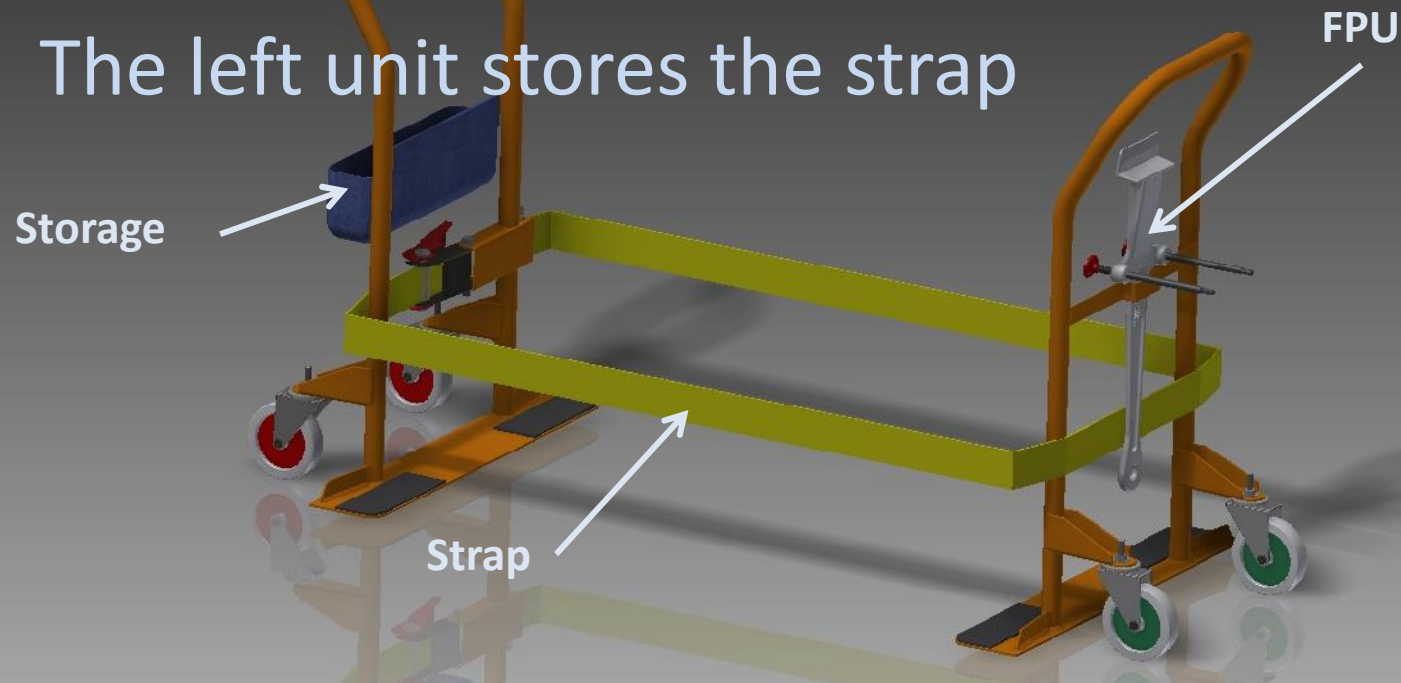
Ratchet Puller

Since the ratchet puller is an integrated part of the Furniture mover, there is less fumbling around.

Now just ratchet the holding strap into position to lock the wheels to the chest.

Everything in It's Place

- Note the FPU storage
- The left unit stores the strap



The strap height has been optimized through many trials to balance wheel security with standard furniture design.

Everything in It's Place

- Each side is self contained
- Carry one in each hand



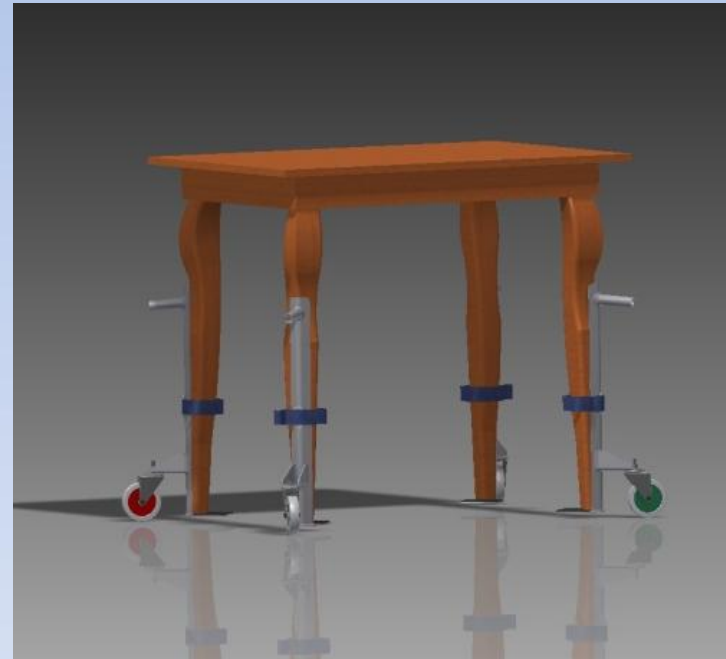


Single Wheel Unit

Use these for irregular shapes



Or to move tables and beds



The Velcro straps are permanently attached for ease of use
Handles are positioned to help lift

Benefits

- Quick Set up
- Better than sliders, especially on new floors
- Large 4" swivel wheels = turns on a dime
- Larger wheels = easier rolling than dollies
- Works well on carpet or hard surfaces
- Handles allow lifting of each end as needed
- Fully loaded cabinets can be moved easily
- Small end to end lifting means better protection of finished product.
